Subject: Grant of Central Government permission for establishment of a new dental college in the name of Malla Reddy Institute of Dental Sciences, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh with an annual intake capacity of 100 admissions in BDS course from the academic session 2013-14.

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 15.07.2013 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that Dental Council of India vide its letter No. DE-22-2013/6438 dated 12.08.2013 informed that in view of the order/directions dated 6.8.2013 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP(C) No(s). 22704/2013 filed by GSL Educational Society Vs. DCI and Anr., the Executive Committee of DCI recommended to the Central Government to grant its permission for establishment of new dental colleges for starting of BDS course with 100 seats at Malla Reddy Institute of Dental Sciences, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh which was earlier recommended by DCI for 50 seats, for the academic year 2013-14, after obtaining the remaining Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs. 100.00 lakhs from the applicant.


2. Further the applicant vide their letter No. CES/MRIDS/EST/2013-2014/07 dated 14.07.2013 (received on 14.08.2013) has already submitted the remaining Performance Bank Guarantee No. 020513IGPER0016 dated 03.07.2013 of Rs.100 lakhs issued by issued by Andhra Bank, Hyderabad, valid upto 02.07.2018.

3. In view of the above, the formal permission of the Central Government is hereby conveyed under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to Chandramma Educational Society, Secunderabad, Andhra Pradesh for establishing a new dental college in the name of Malla Reddy Institute of Dental Sciences, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh with an annual intake capacity of 100 seats instead of 50 seats in BDS course from the academic session 2013-14.

4. This permission is valid for only one year and for admitting only one batch of students during the academic session 2013-14. The next batch of students will be admitted in the college only after renewal of Central Government Permission.

5. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.
