Ref: - Orders of the Vice – Chancellor, Dated: 17.12.2021.

The notification is issued for registration of the candidates for BDS Final Year Regular Examinations commencing from **19.01.2022**.

Eligibility to appear for BDS Final Year Regular Examinations, January 2022:

1. The BDS Final year students who have been admitted during the academic year 2017-18 in the Dental colleges affiliated to KNRUHS in Telangana State, and also students of academic year 2016-17 who have failed, detained and not written the previous BDS Final year examinations are eligible to appear for BDS Final year examinations subject to the fulfillment of regulations.
2. The BDS Final year students who are having minimum **75% of attendance** and appeared for internal assessment examinations are eligible to appear the examinations.
3. A Candidate who has not successfully completed the previous BDS Examinations cannot appear for next higher BDS examination.
4. The calculation of attendance percentage will be up to **10.12.2021**.
5. The uploading of the attendance & internal marks of the candidates is from **22.12.2021 to 24.12.2021**.
6. The confirmation date for attendance & internal marks shall be on **25.12.2021**.

Digital Valuation and Providing only single answer booklet without additional answer booklet:

The University is a Digital campus and implementing digital valuation for all courses. For BDS Final year exam, single answer booklet with 64 writable pages with candidate specific bar code on each page for the candidates appearing for examinations and no additional answer book will be issued to the candidates. The candidates should answer all the questions in the single answer booklet of 64 writable pages only.


The practical/ Clinical and Viva Examination dates will be announced later.
